Terms and conditions

Your bake may be sold or auctioned to make money for Peace Hospice Care, either after the judging or as part of the judging.

Bakes must be delivered to St Mary's Church, Church Street, Watford, WD18 0EG, between **9:00am-10:00am** on **Saturday 7th October**. There is no parking at the Church but the Church Car Park is close by.

Peace Hospice Care, Watford Bid or St Mary's Church take no responsibility for any damage to your bake or any packaging that is left. It is recommended that you bring your bake in a disposable card cake box.

Items which require chilled storage may not be entered e.g. they must not contain fresh cream due to bakes being left at room temperature during the event.

Whilst baking, please follow these procedures:

- You may not produce cakes for the Bake Off if you or any family member is suffering from any contagious illness or has done so in the previous 48 hours.
- Make sure that there is no raw food in the area you are using and do not handle raw food whilst baking.
- Make sure that bowls and other equipment are clean.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before starting to prepare food.
- Store your bake in a clean container.
- Please bring a list of ingredients and potential allergens used in your bake with you on the day.
